We use the Mit markers D4Mit17 and D4Mit244 to genotype whirler mice. D4Mit17 is deleted in whirler mice and D4Mit244 is polymorphic between wi/wi and wi/+ mice. D4Mit17 is 144bp.

In hets D4Mit244 is 110 bp and in homozygous mice it is slightly bigger around 130 bp. It is same size in wild type and het mice. I use an annealing temperature of between 55 and $58\,^{\circ}\text{C}$.
